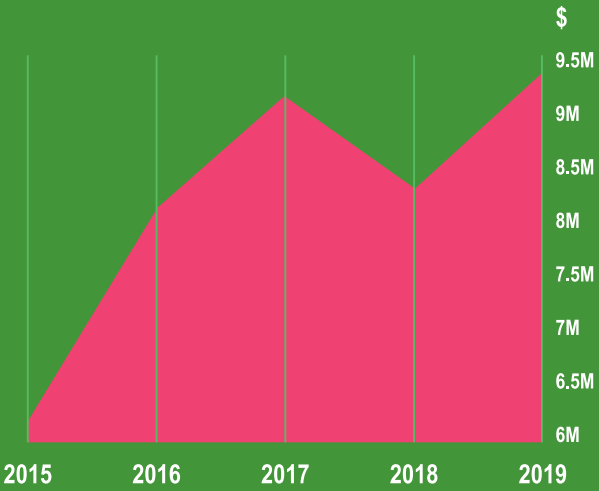


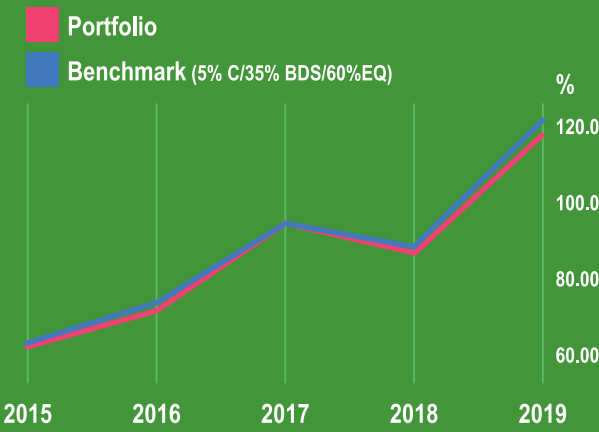

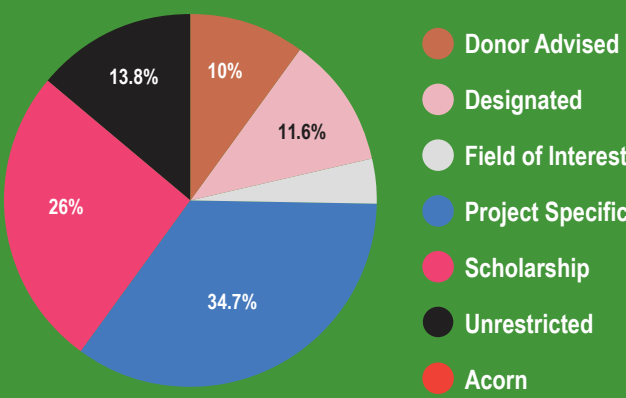
Annual Ending Market Values

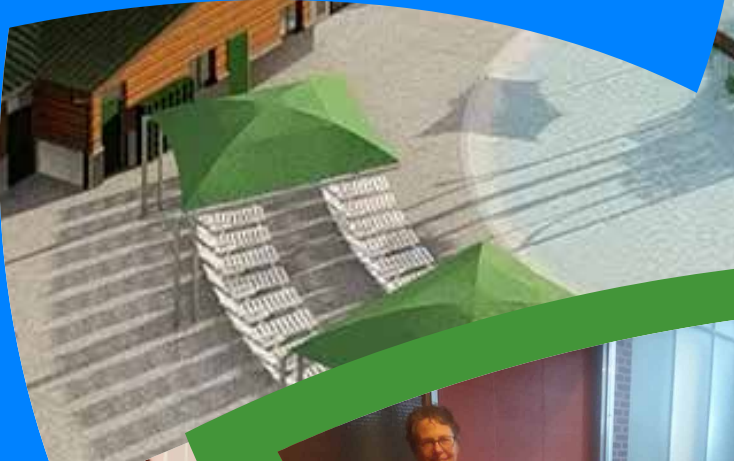
